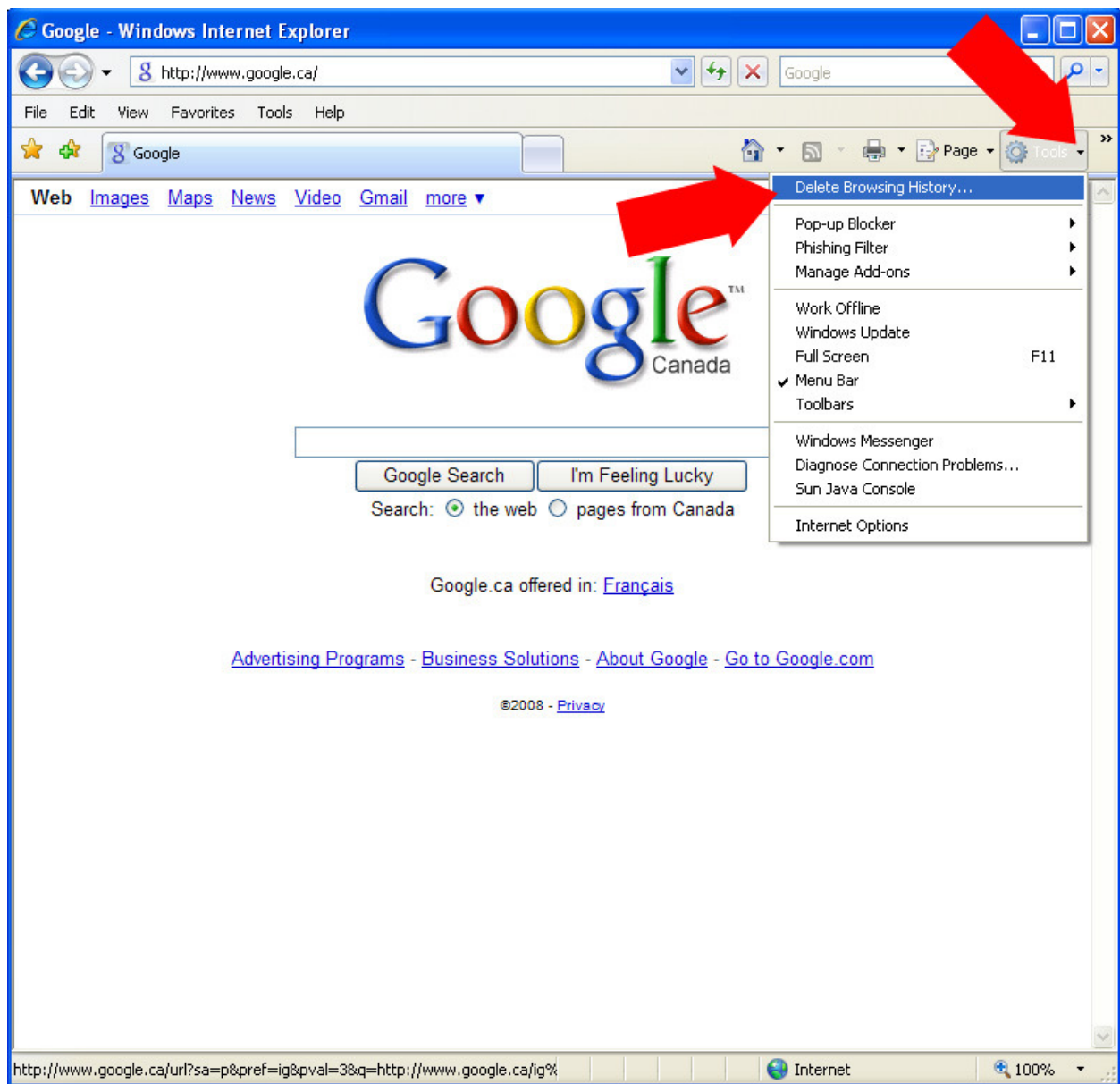


Personal Safety While Using the Internet

While you are using Internet Explorer to surf the internet it is recording all the websites you have visited. While this feature is great for most users, if your level of trust has declined with other people that also use your computer you may want to erase these footprints you have left behind.

For most versions of Internet Explorer you can simply click a button to erase your browser history. Here's how in version 7, which is the most common version used on Windows XP (if you use Vista you are probably using IE v8 which has a slightly different layout).

To erase your browsing history; from the Toolbar at the top of the screen click the Tools menu and then click the "Delete Browsing History..." item.



Personal Safety While Using Google Toolbar

While you may be erasing your browsing history in Internet Explorer, you may also have Google Toolbar installed. Google Toolbar also tracks and records all of the searches you have done on the google.com website.

To erase your Google Toolbar history; drop the list of search history down from the search dropdown box and click "Clear History".
